

In 2021, we raised \$512,299, which is the first time we have raised over half a million dollars since 2014. Again, thank you for your steadfast support. We look forward to working with you in 2022 and seeing you at one of our many in-person events!



Total Receipts \$512,299


Federal Disbursements.....\$228,000



Total Receipts by Year




New Individual Donors





Infrastructure Investment and Jobs Act (IIJA) Signed into Law

- **\$477 billion in new funding over five years for surface transportation programs;**
- **Compromise to establish pilot program for younger drivers'**
- **Compromise automatic emergency braking provision;**
- **Language to stem passenger vehicle distracted driving;**
- **Language to combat and educate drivers about marijuana-impaired driving; and**
- **Language directing a CMV crash causation study and highway cost allocation study.**

- **ATA fought to keep harmful, anti-trucking measures out:**
 - HOS reform rollbacks;
 - Returning CSA scores to public view;
 - Side and front underride guard mandates;
 - Harmful labor provisions; and
 - Unworkable climate mandates



Staved Off the PRO Act and Build Back Better

ATA remains opposed to the Protecting the Right to Organize (PRO) Act

- Would eliminate the independent contractor model for trucking.
- Would further destabilize our supply chain and economy.

ATA remains opposed to \$3.5 trillion Build Back Better tax and spend proposal and future piecemeal approaches

- Legislation currently DOA in the Senate.
- Senators Manchin (D-WV) and Sinema (D-AZ) continue to oppose.

Moving Forward

As you receive this Annual Report, the world finds itself in perilous times as a horrific war in Ukraine unfolds before us. While dwarfed by the untold suffering of the Ukrainian people, the impact of that conflict reverberates here at home as surging fuel prices create new challenges for the trucking industry. Like the COVID-19 pandemic, it is yet another reminder as to how events near and far will always impact this industry and our ability to keep America moving forward. And it underscores the vital need of our ongoing advocacy efforts, which begin with your contributions and support.

In response to these recent events, the American Trucking Associations (ATA) is calling upon the Biden Administration and Congress to unleash America's energy dominance by boosting domestic production of oil and natural gas and eliminating our reliance on adversarial nations that pose a threat to our national and economic security. We will continue to put pressure on policy-makers to strengthen the United States' position in global energy markets so that we have greater pricing power over the resources that fuel our economy.

Other important policy matters that Washington must contend with in the weeks and months ahead include the implementation and full funding of last year's landmark bipartisan infrastructure law. Having played a leading role in the enactment of that legislation, ATA's advocacy team is now working tirelessly to ensure it targets our nation's most acute infrastructure needs, starting with the roads and bridges that motor carriers depend on daily. Given ongoing supply chain disruptions, it is paramount that Congress to dedicate funding for intermodal freight connectors, truck parking capacity and other projects critical to supply chain continuity.

We'll also continue to press Congress and the Administration on other key challenges confronting our industry: a chronic shortage of qualified drivers, and a costly proliferation of abusive lawsuits targeting motor carriers. We're now fighting those battles on a stronger footing than ever before, due largely to the support and engagement of ATA's member companies and the goodwill engendered over two difficult years by an industry that never slowed down and never gave up—despite the many challenges presented by the COVID pandemic.

Those attributes – support, engagement, goodwill – provide the foundation for effective advocacy, and they will be critical as we continue to navigate a closely-divided and bitterly partisan 117th Congress and as we approach the 2022 midterm elections. With control of both the House and Senate hanging in the balance, the outcome of November's midterm election could prove pivotal for our industry. It's imperative that we fully participate in the political process to ensure our voice is heard loudly and clearly. To that end, we welcome and deeply appreciate your continued support of Truck PAC.

Our industry is no stranger to challenges. But as we've shown over these last few tumultuous years, we know how to turn obstacles into opportunities. With your help and support, we look forward to doing just that.
